NOTICE IS HEREBY given pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, ('Rules'), General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, and 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') from time to time ('MCA Circulars'), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations'), Secretarial Standard - 2 on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India ('SS-2') and other applicable laws and regulations (including any statutory modification(s) and/or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), that the resolution as set out in this Notice is proposed to be passed by the Shareholders of Schaeffler India Limited ("Company") through Postal Ballot by way of remote electronic voting (e-voting) process. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the Rules made thereunder and Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations, the Company has engaged the services of the National Depository Services Limited ('NDSL') to provide remote e-voting facility. The procedure for remote e-voting is detailed in the Notes to this Postal Ballot notice.

The proposed resolution and the explanatory statement pertaining to the resolution in terms of the provisions of Section 102 of the Act, as appended hereto forms part of this Postal Ballot Notice.

The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Suresh Kumar Kabra, Partner of Samdani Kabra & Associates, Company Secretaries, Vadodara as scrutinizer to conduct the Postal Ballot through remote e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner. You are requested to carefully read the instructions in this Postal Ballot Notice and record your assent (FOR) or dissent (AGAINST) through the remote e-voting process not later than 5:00 p.m. IST, Thursday, March 21, 2024.

The Board of Directors, on the recommendations of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee has approved the appointment of Mr. Jens Schüler (DIN: 10422738), as an Additional Director (Non-Executive Non-Independent Director) of the Company, w.e.f January 1, 2024, subject to approval of the Members by way of ordinary resolution. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 161 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Mr. Jens Schüler will hold office upto the date of ensuing Annual General Meeting. Further, in terms of Regulation 17(1)(1c) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations And Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations'), approval of members of the Company is required to be obtained for appointment of a Director, at the next general meeting or within a time period of three months from the date of appointment, whichever is earlier. Therefore, the approval of members is being sought for the aforesaid appointment of Mr. Jens Schüler through this Postal Ballot. The Company has received a notice in writing from a Member, in terms of Section 160 of the Act, proposing the appointment of Mr. Jens Schüler as a Director of the Company. Mr. Jens Schüler studied economics at Johannes Gutenberg University Mainz and started his career in 2002 at Deutsche Börse AG as Specialist XETRA Market Supervision. Mr. Schüler has been associated with the Schaeffler Group since 2003 and brings with him over 21 years of professional experience. In 2003, Mr. Schüler has joined Schaeffler Automotive Aftermarket GmbH & Co. KG as Assistant to the Board of Directors. This was followed by professional stages in the Aftermarket business, in which he was responsible for strategic projects within the sales organization in a leading position. In 2009, Mr. Schüler was appointed to the Schaeffler Global Board of the Automotive Aftermarket business unit and, as Vice President, was responsible for strategic planning and project management. Two years later, he took over the management of the Automotive Aftermarket business unit in North America. In 2014, he was additionally given responsibility for the Aftermarket business in South America. With the establishment of Automotive Aftermarket as an Executive Board function at Schaeffler, in 2018, Mr. Schüler took over as Head of Global Sales and Marketing. In 2022, Mr. Jens Schüler was appointed as a member of Schaeffler AG's Executive Board and is responsible for the Schaeffler Group's Automotive Aftermarket business.

Mr. Jens Schüler is not related to any other Director or Key Managerial Personnel of the Company or relatives of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel. Except Mr. Jens Schüler and his relatives, none of the other Directors, Key Managerial Personnel or any of their respective relatives are, in any way,
